On Tuesday 12 December we went to the Harry Potter studios. When we arrived, we were given passports to collect stamps from each room.


We visited the Death Eaters where we saw Bellatrix Lestrange and Voldemort. We visited Gryffindor Common Room and saw snitches suspended in the air.
